Crested Butte is a historic mining town on the western slopes of Colorado. The ski area has 121 trails, 16 lifts and three terrain parks, providing a great experience for beginners and experienced skiers alike.

Lodging:

Gunnison, Colorado

We will have hotel-style lodging in nearby Gunnison, within walking distance of shops and restaurants in this historic mining town located in a valley near the Continental Divide. Our chartered bus will transport us to the ski base area every day.

Transportation:

Cowtown Charters

Luxury 56 passenger bus equipped with chains and cables. Holds a #1 rating from the DOT (highest rating possible).

Bus will be with our group the entire trip.



Cost Estimate:

All inclusive pricing (transportation, lodging, lift tickets, rental equipment, most meals):

\$600 for skiers

\$400 for non-skiers

Pricing is dependent on a variety of group discounts and options. Actual final cost will vary but is not expected to exceed these budget estimates.

Participation Requirement
